What does Opt-In Mean?

- 1. It does not mean that you will immediately start receiving text messages.
- 2. It means that you have indicated your willingness to receive important messages from the service should your child's school or the District tries to send a text message to your number from their SchoolMessenger account.

What Do I Need To Do?

- 1. Make sure that your child's school has your correct cell number. If you have not already provided that information to your child's school, please contact them.
- 2. Perform the Opt-In Process.

You will know you were successful if you receive the following reply message:

You can unsubscribe at any time. You can opt-in and opt-out as many times as you would like.

Text any one of the following words (stop, quit, remove or unsubscribe) to the number 67587 or 68453.

The District will be officially launching the new service in a month, so until then, you will not receive any further text messages.
